

SBID

The SBID symbol of accreditation is the marque that demonstrates a professional commitment to achieving the highest possible standards across the interior design industry. For manufacturers, this appellation provides a competitive advantage and endorses professional expertise of the company.

ELIGIBILITY

An industry partner will be a manufacturer, supplier or provider of support services. Accepted applications will demonstrate the following prerequisites in accordance with the SBID International code of conduct as detailed below:

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

SBID fights piracy and copyright theft in design. We actively negotiate with government to legislate against bad practice. The professional industry partner will also share this commitment.

SERVICE

SBID believes a responsible supplier needs to provide a long term quality service as well as after sales care. The prospective partner will share this commitment to exceptional service.

VALUE FOR MONEY

Products and services must demonstrate good value.

CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY

SBID supports ethical manufacturing and the delivery of products and services that ensure people and environments are not abused or harmed in the production process. The professional industry partner should demonstrate their commitment delivering corporate social responsibility.

SUSTAINABILITY

SBID promotes sustainability in all business activities. The professional industry partner should demonstrate their commitment to sustainability.



We reject or redirect applications from individuals or companies that do not meet these criteria.



MEMBER LEVELS

There are three key membership levels for professional industry partners providing greater choice and allowing the best value for individual members, SMEs and larger organisations.

PARTNER

The basic partner level is the secondary level of membership. To be eligible for accreditation at this level, partners have to provide 1 year of company accounts and a signed declaration of the SBID 5 points of compliance.

The fee for SBID Partner accreditation is **£650 + VAT**.

PARTNER (SME)

The Partner SME level is the preliminary level of membership and is suited to small and medium sized enterprises with a turnover of under 3 million per annum. To be eligible for accreditation at this level, partners have to provide 1 year of company accounts and a signed declaration of the SBID 5 points of compliance.

The fee for SBID Partner accreditation is **£400** + **VAT**.

PLATINUM PARTNER

This level includes the full package of what SBID has to offer including hosting networking opportunities and much more. To be eligible for accreditation at this level, partners should provide a signed declaration of the SBID 5 points of compliance.

The fee for SBID Partner accreditation is £6,000 + VAT.

ENHANCED MEMBERSHIPS

SBID also offers the option to enhance your membership and add extra features to standard membership, allowing you to better connect with the SBID network via our newsletter, social media and eSociety magazine at no additional charge.

CPD

Continuing Professional Development (CPD) is the way by which all professionals maintain and update their industry knowledge and skills after formal education.
